



Sake

Sho Chiku Bai(松竹梅) Crème De Sake Nigori 300ml \$12

Bold and sweet. Rich and robust flavor with distinctive rice savor

Ozeki (大關)Junmai Nigori \$15/375ml

With its velvety texture and creamy flavor this unfiltered sake offers a crisp and vibrant presence.

Rihaku (李白) Dreamy Clouds Jumai Nigori \$35/300ml \$72/720ml

Bright and lean in the mouth, the impact is chewy with sweet rice flavors intermingling with the nutty and slightly fruity characteristics of the sake.

Gekkeikan (月桂冠) Black & Gold \$40/750ml

Full-bodied with hints of honeydew, papaya, anise, and roasted nuts. Well balanced, finishes long and smooth.

Eiko Fuji Ban Ryu (栄光富士. 万流) Honjozo \$9/5oz.

Round, soft, comfy and cozy this incredibly velvety sake has almost a “fluffy” in mouth feel. Its versatility made it possible to be served chilled, warmed, hot, with light food, heavy food, sweet food, and spicy food.

Horin (鳳麟)Ultra-Premium Junmai Daiginjo \$35/300ml

A combination of fresh spring water, Yamada Nishiki rice (known as the ‘king of sake rice’), Gohyakumangoku rice milled to 50%, and the skill of the sake master, result in this classic example of a Fushimi style Junmai Daiginjo

Kikusui (菊水)Junmai Ginjo \$60/720ml

Light and comfortably dry, with the aroma of fresh cantaloupe and banana followed by medium body bringing refreshing Mandarin orange like overtones.

Seikyo Takehara Junmai “Mirror of Truth” (誠鏡) \$55/720ml \$100/1.8L

Meticulously crafted with locally grown koji rice in Hiroshima, this junmai sake offers a solid taste and rich flavor with hints of honey and brown butter

Tengumai (天狗舞) Junmai Daiginjo \$70/720ml

Limes and mushrooms on the nose, with a sharp and fruity flavor. Refreshing, medium-bodied with a surprising lifted finish. Tengumai brews its exquisite sake with naturally filtered volcanic water.

Kubota Hekiju (久保田. 碧寿) Junmai Daiginjo \$90/720ml

This Daiginjo, which is called a Ginjo in the store, is the perfect example of a Niigata style sake known as tanrei karakuchi or light and dry. Great with seared scallop and white fish sashimi.

Dassai (獺祭) 39 Junmai Daiginjo \$105/720ml

Brewed with rice milled down to exactly 39% of its original size, Dassai 39 offers notes of honey, Asian pears, and bananas. Elegant in texture and flavor with a slightly acidic finish

Hakkaisan (八海山) Junmai Ginjo \$120/720ml

With a 50% rice-polishing ratio, this Genshu(undiluted) Sake presents an incredible round and smooth taste after 3 years of aging in the snow
